Mustard Pancakes is designed to contribute to preschool children's social and emotional development, with a secondary focus on literacy and storytelling. Specifically, the series is built upon a substantive educational curriculum that addresses three primary goals:

1. To support and nurture a sense of self-esteem and self-efficacy among three- to six-year-old children, by encouraging them to demonstrate respect for themselves and others.
2. To foster the development of children's social and emotional skills by modeling age-appropriate strategies and behaviors.
3. To stimulate children's interest in literacy and storytelling, and to encourage them to express themselves creatively by sharing stories of their own.

Growing from this foundation, every episode of the series conveys important socioemotional content regarding topics such as cooperation, diversity, respect for others, or coping with failure. Throughout production, I reviewed each script and collaborated with the production team to ensure that the stories and their educational content would be age-appropriate and educationally viable for their target audience.
